Dear Indigo Plantation Owners,

For the past several months the Indigo Plantation POA Board, like many other HOA boards in the region, has been discussing the call by some of their owners to consider removing "Plantation" from their neighborhood's name. Discussion on this issue continues to appear in our local newspapers as well. In order to give Indigo POA owners an opportunity to voice their perspective and opinions on this issue, the board is conducting a very short, anonymous, online survey.

Along with this survey, we thought it would be helpful to provide some insight, perspective and history about the area from some of Southport's Black leaders and long-time residents - see links below. This was done via Zoom on Sept. 23 with POA Board members Ginny Prunty and Gina Poppe. In addition, Barbara Burrell, an Indigo owner who has professional expertise in surveys, was also asked to attend along with Misty Plummer, Indigo Association Manager. We asked Hannah Funderburke, a non-owner who grew up in Southport and who has experience in moderating these type of issue-based community meetings, to moderate the meeting. The video is about an hour long.
